For others it is their first taste of a home, walking on hard wood, tile etc, having their own bed and learning how wonderful life can be.

Maybe you can't donate money but you can donate time and love, fostering is the solution to your problem. Maybe you travel sometimes for work and can't have a full time pet; fostering is a great way to help us and still enjoy time with a dog on your schedule.
